- For those wishing to submit under the Early Career track, eligibility is open to those who received their Ph.D. no earlier than January 1, 2013. Current postdocs and project scientists are encouraged to submit proposals, and if successfully funded, must have a scientific job title (career or career track, research scientist or staff scientist) before the project starts.
- Deputies and Division Directors will work with Early Career applicants to develop a mentoring plan.
- All FY22 LDRD projects will be required to present a project update to Area leadership. This includes projects for which renewal funding WILL NOT be requested.
