BSA FY25 LDRD Process

The FY25 Laboratory Directed Research and Development (LDRD) process has now been initiated. There will be Area-wide, Early Career, and Multi-Area Initiative tracks. Please see a description of these tracks in the <u>call for proposals</u> and the FY25 Bioscience Area priorities <u>here</u>. The highest-ranking proposal submitted by an Early Career researcher (i.e., *Ph.D. received no earlier than January 1, 2013*) will be recommended for funding as the Area's selection for the Early Career track. Candidates at all levels of their careers are encouraged to apply for LDRD funding.

This is a highly competitive process. Therefore, we are seeking high-quality and high-impact proposals. An important consideration for LDRD submissions are opportunities for synergy, building new capabilities/areas of research, the potential for future funding, and Area proposals, as well as linkage to the <u>Biosciences Strategic Plan - Looks Ahead to 2028</u>, <u>Berkeley Lab COVID-19 Strategic Plan</u>, <u>DOE BER Biological Systems Science Division (BSSD) Strategic Plan</u>, National Academies reports, or other strategic and forward-looking documents.

- For those wishing to submit under the ECD track, eligibility is open to those who
 received their PhD no earlier than January 1, 2013. Current postdocs and project
 scientists are encouraged to submit proposals, and if successfully funded, must
 have a scientific job title (career or career track, research scientist or staff
 scientist) before the project starts. Exceptional approval from the Directorate is
 required for Scientific Engineering Associates (SEAs) who wish to serve as PI on
 a project.
- Deputies and Division Directors will work with Early Career applicants to develop a mentoring plan.
- All current FY24 LDRD projects will be required to present a project update to Area leadership. This includes projects for which renewal funding WILL NOT be requested.
